Before and After School



To ensure that all children are safe before and after school on the playground could I please kindly ask that children are supervised at all times before the doors open at 8:45 and at the end of the day after 3 o'clock.

If your child rides a bike or scooter to and from school please ask your child to dismount the cycle at the entrance gate before entering the playground to minimise the risk of any accidents. Please remember to take scooters and bikes home. Whilst waiting to collect your child at the end of the day please stand back from the playground door so that teachers can see all adults who are waiting. Please do not crowd around the door as this makes it difficult for the children to get to their parent.

As you can see we now have our fabulous nursery class which opened last week. The field has been levelled and seeded. In order to give the grass seed the best chance to grow please don't let children onto the field before or after school. The trim trail and train will be out of use for a while to let the field recover from all the heavy machinery use during the past few months
